FEE STRUCTURE

At the time of competitive registration the entire year's tuition fees **must be paid in full OR you may leave post-dated cheques/highlight the EMT option below**. You have the option to pay for your Competitive Tuition: Full, Two Term Installments or Monthly. *(Please date cheques on the 15th of each month October-June for monthly payments, and October 15th 2018 & February 15th 2019 for those paying in two term installments).*

COMPETITIVE DANCE PACKAGES

(Costume Deposits and Competition Entry Fees are NOT included. Costume Deposits are due on October 1st 2018 - fees below are based on yearly, two term, or 9 monthly installments. All fees include tax).

** Occasionally extra choreography fees may apply. We will inform you of which dances will be affected as extra lessons and fees may be required. Also note that a Costume Deposit of \$50 per dance will be required by October 1st 2018. **

Please keep in mind the following: Studio Policies

RECREATIONAL STUDENTS:

- If your child is not happy with their chosen class don't worry– we will switch their class or offer a refund on classes (based on date of withdrawal), minus a 10% administrative fee until October 31st, 2018. **After October 31st, 2018 there ARE NO REFUNDS on classes or costume deposit.** All withdrawals must be done in person. A parent must fill out a withdrawal form in order to receive their refund cheque.
- There is a \$30.00 fee for **ALL NSF payments.**
- A \$20 per week charge will be added to all late payments.
- We are pleased to offer a 10% discount for families with more than one child registered for classes. This will be taken off the cost of the second child's lessons (equal or lesser value) **OR** when registering during our early registration period only when registering for all three technical classes: ballet, tap and jazz. This does not apply to costume deposits.
- If you are paying in two installments the second cheque must be dated no later than October 1st, 2018.
- Recreational costumes range in price between \$60-\$110 (minus your \$30 costume deposit per dance) and are yours to keep! The balance owing is due in May or June when costumes are ready for pick up.
- Recital Tickets go on sale early May and are approximately \$25 plus service fees. Please make sure you are on our email list to stay up to date with all the latest information from the studio! Also check our studio website (www.dancecollectivestudio.ca), 'like' us on Facebook and follow us on Instagram to stay up to date!
- Dance Collective does not offer makeup classes, refunds or credits for students who miss class. The studio will only ever cancel classes due to weather conditions or extreme teacher illness. Dance Collective reserves the right to do so without making up the class. In the unlikely event that more than one evening/day of the same classes has to be cancelled due to weather, we will do our best to make it up if studio scheduling allows. We thank you for your understanding.

COMPETITIVE STUDENTS:

(All the above applies plus the following):

- Competitive Costumes can cost up to \$210 per costume. Costumes are custom made and the dancer's to keep. As they are worn numerous times and are part of the competitive mark, they must be ornate and durable.
- Costume deposits for all competitive routines (\$50 per routine) must be paid in full by October 1st 2018 and are non-refundable. **New students must purchase a jacket (\$170).**
- Competitive Students who withdraw from the competitive program before November 1st are eligible for a refund on classes only, but **costume deposits and clothing are non-refundable.**
- The balance of the competition entry fees must be paid in full no later than **January 1st 2019.** The studio reserves the right to charge interest to any late accounts (\$20 per week on unpaid balance).

STUDIO CODE OF CONDUCT:

Dance Collective is committed to providing a safe and uplifting dance experience for all. We ask that everyone follow our code of conduct in order to help create a positive, memorable and fun dance experience!

Dancers:

- Arrive on time and ready for all of your classes
- Maintain a positive attitude
- Treat your teacher and other dancers with respect – always!
- No foul language, chewing gum, or cell phones in class
- Notify your teacher immediately of any injury or illness
- Always give 100% in every class

Parents:

- Maintain a positive attitude and encourage your dancer
- Enjoy watching your child grow and learn new things
- Drop off and pick up your child on time
- Notify a teacher or admin immediately of any injury or illness before scheduled classes
- Trust the professional guidance of the instructors at Dance Collective

Finally, dancers and parents are simply asked to conduct themselves in a way that promotes respect, and encourages others to always be their best self. Any actions, whether they are verbal, written, or physical that are perceived as intimidating, threatening or otherwise hostile, are strictly forbidden. Parents and students that choose not to follow the studio code of conduct will be removed from the studio immediately without refund.
